# WORK & PROJECTS

#### INTEGRATION PATTERNS

#### BATTERIES PLUS

With the strategy to move away from BizTalk Server and towards scalable cloud solutions, I designed and implemented a new integration pattern to be used at Batteries Plus. I introduced a new process where applications published events to the Azure Event Grid, event handler Azure Functions would then use identifiers to retrieve domain objects and publish them to the Azure Service bus. From there subscribers could pick up the domain objects and integrate the data into the destination applications. This new process allowed us to decouple non-critical path processing and introduced reliable messaging.

# EMAIL SERVICE PROVIDER IMPLEMENTATION BATTERIES PLUS

I was the IT representative for researching and purchasing an ESP for the marketing department. I was involved in all meetings, along with the business stakeholders, when meeting with 3rd party providers. After deciding on a provider, I worked closely with their technical team, designed our integration processes to send data using their RESTful API's, and developed and implemented the functions to pass the data along. I designed and implemented the integration processes in a generic manner using interfaces that allowed us to switch providers in the future with very little effort.

### ON PREMISE TO CLOUD MIGRATION BATTERIES PLUS

I was highly involved in the migration of our applications from on premise servers to Azure Cloud Services. We moved our web applications, API's, databases, and integration processes into various Azure services. I worked on implementing search solutions using Azure Search and CosmosDB, updating application code to prepare for migration, created build and release pipelines, and modified ARM Templates for Azure resource management.

## WEBSITE & BACKEND DEVELOPMENT BUZZFANTASYGOLF.COM

I originally created the website using .NET WebForms and have since started the migration to using .NET Core Blazor Server. I designed and developed the database using MS SQL Server, and have used Azure Service Bus and Azure Functions to handle backend processing and integrations. I implemented PayPal as the payment gateway for the website, and integrated with SendGrid to handle automated emails.
